 Nancy Johnson Outstanding New Professional Teacher Award

The purpose of this award is to recognize new teachers employed full-time in the classroom that provides outstanding Career and Technical Education programs for youth. Recipients of this award early in their careers demonstrate professional commitment and have made significant contribution toward innovative, unique and novel Family and Consumer Sciences programs. **Nominees must have taught in Family and Consumer Sciences programs for a minimum of three but not more than five years. The nominee also should have been involved in some capacity with the Association of Career and Technical Education (ACTE) activities at the local and/or state level. The applicant must be an active member of FACSE, ACTE and WA-ACTE for the past three consecutive years.** Area groups and individuals are encouraged to nominate educators who are deserving of this honor.

Pages 10-15: Five (5) one page letters of support. These letters should come from the following individuals: <input type="checkbox"/> (page 10) Nominees immediate supervisor; <input type="checkbox"/> (page 11) Administrator; <input type="checkbox"/> (page 12) Current or former student; <input type="checkbox"/> (page13) Parent , advisory board member or community lay person; <input type="checkbox"/> (page14-15) Two additional letters of choice (church/athletics/community group etc.)
<input type="checkbox"/> All materials word processed or typed
<input type="checkbox"/> One original and five (5) photocopied three-hole punched documents of the completed materials should be submitted.
Please note award recipients original portfolios will be submitted to WA-ACTE for State and National Recognition.

The original portfolio should be sent in a binder, however each additional copy must be three-hole punched and stapled only. All materials must be submitted with the original portfolio package and postmarked no later than **JUNE 1st**.
